

ThorGuard Lightning Detection

ThorGuard Lightning Detection protects both North Park and Spring Lake Park. Below outlines how the detection system functions.

Signal: One long 15-second blast indicates red alert in which conditions are favorable for a lightning strike in the area. A white strobe light on top of the maintenance building at North Park is activated.

Action: All play is to cease immediately. Everybody to seek shelter; preferably inside cars.

All Clear Signal: Three short 5-second blasts and strobe light turns off both indicate all is clear. This is a minimum of 20 minutes after the initial alert. Play may resume.
